

Water Savers: Project Prime Minister

A study of practical ways to save water in and around the home.



You are the Prime Minister of Australia. You want to solve the problem of people wasting water in the home.

You have to report to Parliament on this issue explaining how water is used inside the various rooms of the home and in the garden and recommend how people could save water.

How you present your report (to your class) is your choice. You might like to make a speech, prepare a photographic display, use a form of creative writing such as comic strips or present a written report, or some combination of these.

Click on Play and watch the introduction to meet the Wilson family household – you can select Skip Intro in future.

After watching Intro note the information icons, the 'i' droplets, on the screen showing the Wilson house. They are on either side near the bottom of the screen. Click on these to see a slide and a video.
